Wellspring Interfaith Social Services has seen an increase in the number of clients seeking food assistance.

In the past month, the demand for Wellspring Interfaith Social Services' food bank has surged to unprecedented levels. We are now serving 250 families per week, a significant increase from last year's 135. Some of these families are turning to a food bank for the first time.
